

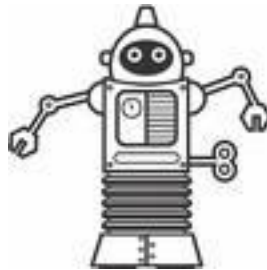
“Adventure Land” Summer Camp 2010
